Some people with disabilities have problems due to flooding. DLAC can help with information. DLAC can give referrals. DLAC can also help with general disaster issues.

We can provide information and referral about issues like the following:

- People who are turned away from emergency shelters due to being assisted by service animals
- People whose communication needs (sign language interpreters, alternate formats, etc.) are not being met by emergency shelters or other service providers
- Loss of durable medical equipment
- Loss of prescription medication
- Loss of Social Security check or inability to get to location where the check was mailed

These are only examples. We will try to help with other issues.
